

**STAGE POSITIONS** 

Upstage means away from the footlights, downstage means toward the footlights, and right and left are used with reference to the actor as he faces the audience. R means right, L means left, U means up, D means down, C means center, and these abbreviations are used in combination, as: U R for upright, R C for right center, D L C for down left center, etc. One will note that a position designated on the stage refers to a general territory, rather than to a given point.

NOTE: Before starting rehearsals, chalk off your stage or rehearsal space as indicated above in the *Chart of Stage Positions*. Then teach your actors the meanings and positions of these fundamental terms of stage movement by having them walk from one position to another until they are familiar with them. The use of these abbreviated terms in directing the play saves time, speeds up rehearsals, and reduces the amount of explanation the director has to give to his actors.

## GENESIS

SCENE: Low levels Downstage Right. Upstage Left are higher levels. The rest of the stage remains bare for the flow of the action.

AT RISE: GROUP I, the Spirits of Good, stand in spearhead formation Down Center, facing half-right, their heads thrown back as if flying. Upstage on the high levels, GROUP II, Spirits of a Higher Order, are arranged permanently. Eve lies face down on the floor before GROUP II, unseen until she rises.

Sound: Two slow clashes of the cymbals. The curtain opens on darkness.

LIGHTS: During the first three lines, a very faint blue light grows on GROUP I.

[NOTE: GROUP I chants the days of Creation with marked rhythm. There is a silent beat at the end of each line, as the play is printed. Wherever there is movement, the rhythm should become even more marked. GROUP II uses slow, majestic gestures of the hands and head; the body remains motionless. When not speaking, each Chorus freezes; facial expression, however, always responds to the action of the scene. Adam does not appear; his lines are given by GROUP I, with suitable imitation.]

#### GROUP I

And the earth was void and empty, And darkness was upon the face of the deep,

And the spirit of God moved over the waters, [Slowly lifting faces to GROUP II] And God said:

#### GROUP II

Be light made.

[LIGHTS: Spot stabs down on GROUP II.]

#### GROUP I

And there was evening and morning—one day. And God said:

#### GROUP II

Let there be a firmament.

[LIGHTS: Bring up blue on sky drop.]

#### GROUP I

And it was so. [Moving rhythmically toward low platforms Right] And the evening and morning were the second day. And God said:

#### GROUP II

Earth. Seas.

#### GROUP I

And God brought forth of the ground all manner of trees

Fair to behold And pleasant to eat of.

SOLO [from GROUP I] [Walking Down as she speaks] The tree of life also in the midst of Paradise.

#### SOLO [from GROUP I] [Walking Down] And the tree of knowledge Of good and evil.

#### GROUP I

[Moving Right as before] And the evening and morning were the third day. And God created

#### GROUP II

Sun. Moon. And the stars.

#### GROUP, I

[Accelerating, moving Right] And the evening and morning were the fourth day. And God created

#### GROUP II

Fishes. Birds.

#### GROUP I

And He blessed them saying

#### GROUP II

Increase and multiply.

#### GROUP I

[Moving Right, taking positions on levels] And the evening and morning were the fifth day. [Accelerating] And God made the beasts of the field And He saw that they were good [Swiftly lifting faces to GROUP II] And He said:

#### GROUP II

[Lifting their faces] Let us make man to our image and likeness and let him have dominion.

#### GROUP I

[Swiftly facing front, with joy chanting] And God made man to His own image: To the image of God He created him: Male and female He created them. And the Lord God formed man of the slime of the earth, And He breathed into his face the breath of life And man became A living soul! [Extending their arms overhead, in ecstasy]

[SOUND: Soft clash of cymbals. Eve slowly sits up, her

face lifted toward GROUP I and her back to the audience.]

#### GROUP II

Behold I have given you every herb All beasts of the earth Every fowl of the air that you may have to feed upon.

#### GROUP I

And He commanded them saying:

#### GROUP II

Of every tree of Paradise thou shalt eat But of the tree of knowledge of good and evil Thou shalt not eat [Not sternly, but with love] For in what day soever thou shalt eat of it Thou shalt die the death.

#### GROUP I

And God saw all the things that He had made, And they were very good. And the evening and morning were the sixth day And on the seventh day [Folding hands across breast] God rested.

[Eve slowly rises and turns, gazing in wonder and delight at sky and earth.]

And they were before Him playing, playing in the world. Oh, innocence ! Oh, likeness of God looking up from the earth ! [Softly] Likeness of God. They find it in each other's eyes : [Chanting] That beauty not on land or water

[Eve turns and lifts her face to Adam in wonder and love.]

Find and know it good.

#### GROUP II

Let there be love

#### GROUP I

Said Love, And love descended from the Living One To them. Their souls were shaken with the joy thereof And they were young

#### GROUP II

[Softly] with God

#### GROUP I

in the morning of the world.

- [Left hand sweeps toward Eve in a long gesture.] They stand
- [Right hand follows and clasps left.] Hands clasped like children.
- [The following lines are said with pronounced rhythm. Eve sees and responds to the beauties of creation as each is named.]

Sky runs red and gold

#### GROUP II

[Softly] For them

#### GROUP I

And all the stars come one by one shining and singing together

#### GROUP II

All For them.

#### Eve

How lovely thy earth!

#### GROUP I and II

[Softly] How lovely Thy children, O God.

#### GROUP I

The roses are breathing

#### GROUP II

For them

Along a thousand shores They do not see, The white waves crash Sh-sh-sh-sh-sh! [Imitating sound of rushing water]

[Crescendo] Sh-sh-sh!

[Softly] Unheard. And in the garden One small bird Begins to sing

#### GROUP I and II

All

[Barely breathing] For them.

[One of the chorus whistles a soft bird-call, perhaps four notes. Half the Good Spirits run lightly down from levels to Center, and remain there watching

EVE. EVE runs counter to the chorus, toward an imaginary bird, and mimics the bird-call. Another whistles the bird-call; and the remainder of the Good Spirits run down from levels to Center, leaving levels unoccupied. Again EVE runs, to the Left, and mimics the bird. Now the entire chorus joins in whistling bird-calls. EVE runs singing in this forest of bird-song, and at last runs up on levels Right, raising her arms high with one long note of ecstasy. Just as she finishes it, the DEVILS rush out and crouch at the foot of the levels.]

[Sound: Rapid, soft beating of tympany. LIGHTS: Green borders. Dimout CHOBUS I and II.]

#### DEVILS

[Smiling and innocent. They speak rapidly, drawing out the last vowel of each phrase, or the word to be emphasized, with many inflections or a weird whining effect that will cling to the ear long afterward.]

Why hath God commanded you that you should not eat of every tree of Paradise?

[SOUND: Beating of tympany as GROUP I runs Right, surrounding level on which EVE stands, and taking a position of guard with hands crossed on their foreheads, palm out.]

#### Eve

[Wide-eyed, childlike, coming down from levels slowly] Of the fruit of the trees that are in Paradise we do eat:

- But of the fruit of the tree which is in the *midst* of **Para**dise,
- God hath commanded us that we should not eat;

And that we should not *touch* it,

Lest perhaps we die. [She says this word with complete lack of comprehension. There is no fear, and no sadness in her voice.]

#### DEVILS

#### GROUP I

[Casting their hands down, with majesty] Liar! From the beginning!

#### GROUP II

[With pronounced rhythm, slowly] I saw Satan fall like lightning

#### GROUP I

[Calling her softly] Eve! Eve!

[One of the chorus whistles the bird-call, and Eve lifts her head, forgetting temptation.]

#### DEVILS

Shwsh! Shwsh! Shwsh! [Like the rustle of leaves]

#### Solo [from Group I]

[Walking forward to Eve's right side] Consider a thousand trees and their fruit.

[Eve plucks fruit from another tree.]

#### Solo [from Group I]

[Also approaching Eve] Consider the companion who loves thee.

[Eve offers the fruit to Adam. Just as she does so, the Devils pounce their temptation into her mind again.]

#### DEVILS

You shall know You shall be [In a fierce whisper] As gods!

Solo [from Devils] [Sweetly] So small a thing!

SOLO [from DEVILS] Once do it and have done!
