STUDENT #8. You all have been muted. Yes. I have control of the room. I guess when Mr. Rivers was kicked off, control was given to me. I am happy to unmute you again. But we can't talk at the same time. We still have some time left in class. So, until Mr. Rivers gets back, let's do something fun.

(All STUDENTS are unmuted.)

STUDENT #2. What if we order some food?

STUDENT #4. Anyone have a better idea?

STUDENT #1. I got one. Let's play "SorD." (Pronounced "sword.")

STUDENT #6. Yeah. Anyone else ever played it?
