Page 5

• Lucy's third speech: replace "Sorry" with "Oh. Okay."

Page 6

• Lucy's fourth speech should read: "Ooh. One step at a time. I'm sorry. (A pause.)"

Page 7

- Lucy's second speech: After stage direction, add: "What's that?"
- Line below it (Peter's speech) should start out with "Snowballs!"
- Cut next two speeches (Lucy's and Peter's)
- Next speech of Lucy's, first sentence should read: "And what's this?
- Next speech of Peter's, beginning word of stage direction should be: "They" not "The"

Page 12

After Edmund's third speech, add:

- LUCY. Yes, isn't that strange.
- EDMUND. Yes, that's very strange.
- Next speech of Lucy's cut first word "Then" and add: "I thought so too—especially when I saw" etc.

Page 13

• Witch's first speech, after stage direction and first sentence, insert: "And never a day of Christmas!" Then continue with "Faster, you etc."

Page 15

- Edmund's fourth speech, after stage direction and first sentence, second sentence should read "Lucy, Lucy, Lucy, Lucy.
- Then new speech: "LUCY (enters). Yes, Edmund?"
- Then back to finish Edmund's speech: "EDMUND. I just checked out the wardrobe, too," etc."

Page 17

• After Peter's last speech, replace the next five speeches with:

LUCY. I wonder who lives here?

(BEAVER enters.)

BEAVER. Welcome, welcome, welcome. So you've come at last. We've been expecting you. I'm Mr. Beaver.

LUCY. I'm Lucy, and this is my sister Susan, and my brothers Edmund and Peter.

BEAVER. How do you chew. (Shake hands.) This is Mrs. Beaver.

LUCY. How do you chew.

BEAVER. And these are my 17 little Beaver children. Care for some log?

LUCY. Well, I don't know.

• Then continue with Beaver's and Lucy's last two speeches on page.

Page 18

- Lucy's first speech, the first sentence should read: "I'm sorry." Then continue with second sentence as is.
- Beaver's fifth speech, after stage direction, it should read: "She's queen over Narnia and she hunts humans. Mr. Tumnus' job was to turn you over to her.
- Lucy's seventh speech should read: "Oh, no, it's all my fault." etc.
- Next speech of Beaver's, second sentence should be: "You can't do that." Then:

LUCY. Yes, I can.

BEAVER. No, you can't.

LUCY. Yes, I can.

BEAVER (becomes PETER for a second). Lucy, you can't!

LUCY (coming to). Oh—yes, you're right.

• Then go back up to Beaver's eighth speech and continue with:

BEAVER. "Nobody can stand up etc."

- Next line, cut Lucy's first word: "Aslan!!" And after stage direction insert dialogue: "Oh! Oh!"
- Next line, add third sentence: "Want another log?"
- Next line, first sentence should start: "Oh, no," etc.
- Lucy's next speech, cut first sentence. Add new sentence at end: "What is he?"

Page 19

• Cut first two lines of Beaver's first speech, and start out:

BEAVER. Who is Aslan? What do you mean?

LUCY. Well, is Aslan a man?

BEAVER. Aslan a man?! Of course not. Aslan is a lion!

LUCY, A lion!

BEAVER. And not just any old lion. Aslan is the Great Lion. He's as big as a refrigerator... Oh, yes, he is, little Beaver, and sometimes he makes himself as big as a mountain. Now you be quiet and go eat your sticks. Yes, things are changing. Aslan has come back to Narnia, (then continue with Beaver's speech at top, third line: "and he's waiting for you" etc.

- After stage direction cut "**Oops**" and replace with "**Please**"
- Lucy's next speech, first sentence should read: "I'm sorry."

Page 20

- Cut first line.
- Now, new first line sentence should read: "A white wolf!" Then continue with stage direction, etc.
- Edmund's fourth speech, after word "talking" insert: "with Mr. and Mrs. Beaver" then continue with "about going to" etc.

Page 22

- Lucy's third speech, move last sentence "I'm tired" and make it the first sentence.
- Peter's last solo speech on page, last sentence should read: "Lucy, look!"
- Then insert a speech for Lucy: "LUCY. What?"
- Then continue with Peter and Lucy's next speech.

Page 23

Lucy's last speech on page, just before second stage direction, insert: "Remember this moment?"

Page 24

Aslan's first speech, last three words, change word "trade" to "switch"

Page 25

- Fourth line, after "He's dead!" add "Dead."
- Next line, after "I'm so cold." add: "I'm so lonely. Oh, Aslan, please don't go."

Page 27

- First line should end with ellipsis.
- Witch's first speech, first line should start: "**Break** my magic wand, etc. and replace the "!" at end of sentence with a "?"

Page 28

- Lucy's third speech, cut first sentence and replace it with: "I agree, King Peter."
- Peter's fifth speech, third sentence should read: "And that's the story of what happened to us in Narnia."

Page 29

At top of page, cut word "cry" from stage direction and replace with "tear up" then cut: "What's wrong, Lucy?"
